About the Library

Gour Mohan Sachin Mandal Mahavidyalaya Library houses a compact yet diverse collection of textbooks, reference books, journals, and periodicals, covering nearly all subjects offered at the college. The library follows a closed-access system for students, ensuring systematic resource management.

Books are classified using the Dewey Decimal Classification Scheme (19th Edition) and are organized by subject for easy reference. The library is automated with Aclib Library Software, streamlining database management and lending procedures. Additionally, OPAC services allow patrons to explore the library's collection efficiently.

By making effective use of these knowledge resources, users can enhance their learning and research experience.

Location

Gour Mohan Sachin Mandal Mahavidyalaya Library is located in the southern section of the college, behind the Academic Building. This single-story facility includes a Reading Room, Stack Room, Teachers' Corner, and Lending Area, offering essential resources and a conducive learning environment for students and faculty.

Goals of the Library

As an information resource centre, the library plays a crucial role in any academic institution, serving as a hub of knowledge and learning. It provides a diverse range of reading materials and resources to cater to its varied users, including students, administrators, faculty members, and non-teaching staff.

The Gour Mohan Sachin Mandal Mahavidyalaya Library is an integral part of the college, offering valuable information services with the following goals and objectives:

- 1. To provide curriculum-based information resources for users.
- 2. To acquire diverse learning materials that expose users to a broader knowledge base.
- 3. To encourage self-reliance by motivating users to actively engage with library resources.
- 4. To preserve institutional history through systematic documentation.
- 5. To serve as a catalyst in the self-learning process, fostering independent research and exploration.

Salient Features

1. Two shifts

Gour Mohan Sachin Mandal Mahavidyalaya Library operates in two shifts during college hours, except on Sundays and public holidays:

- Morning Shift: 7:00 A.M. 10:30 A.M. (Monday to Saturday)
- Day Shift:
 - 11:00 A.M. 3:00 P.M. (Monday to Friday)

o 11:00 A.M. − 2:00 P.M. (Saturday)

Implementing two shifts in the library offers following advantages:

- ➤ Cater to a larger number of students: With two shifts, students have more flexibility in choosing a time that fits their schedule. Those who may not be able to visit during regular hours due to classes or other commitments can utilize the library during the alternate shift.
- Extended access for faculty and Non-teaching staff: Faculty members and non-teaching staff, who may have busy schedules, can avail the library as per their convenience.
- ➤ Maximized library space and facilities: With two shifts, the library can cater to more users without overcrowding, ensuring that study rooms, computer stations, and other facilities are available to a wider range of students.
- ➤ **Better resource management**: More operating hours mean better utilization of library resources, including books, journals, and online databases.
- ➤ **Promotes self-learning**: Students who prefer quiet, uninterrupted time for studying or research can choose their preferable time slot. The extended hours provide a conducive environment for focused self-learning.

2. Library Automation

At present Aclib Library Software is being used to automate the library database and lending procedures. OPAC services are provided for the patrons to give a glimpse of library collection. TVS LP-45printer is used to prepare barcoded membership card and reading materials. Users can be highly motivated by proper utilization of these knowledge resources.




Fig.1: Cataloguing






Fig.2: Circulation




Barcode Printing Setup




Fig.3: Date-wise holding of books




Fig.4: Library Membership



3. Institutional Membership



➤ **Borrowing of Books**: Users can borrow books for a specified period, allowing them to take resources home for further reading and study.





- ➤ **Daily Newspaper Reading**: The library offers access to daily newspapers, keeping users informed about current events, local and international news, and developments in various fields.







5. WEBINAR




